Read and Discuss Together

1. Read the Third Petition from the small catechism and "What is this?" of the Lord's Prayer

- 2. What do you think we are asking for in this petition of the Lord's Prayer?
- 3. How do you think we know what God wants us to do? When you are in class, how do you know what your teachers expect of you? When you are at home, how do you know what your parents expect of you?

Listening to God is the Key to knowing God's will.

4. How do we listen?

Prayer: Prayer is not always about saying words. Prayer is also about listening in silence for God to provide us with insight, wisdom and clarity.

5. How are you at staying still and listening to what is around you?

Bible and Writing

6. Read Psalm 46: 10a

Practice: Close eyes and be still and quiet for 3 minutes Take note of the senses around you: sound, smells, touch (like a breeze)

7. Write: How hard was it to stay still? What were some of the things you noticed?

Jesus gave us this prayer to listen and pray that each and every day we ask that we might be instruments of God. To do God's will.

- 8. Read Matthew 22: 37 39 and Matthew 25: 34 40
- 9. Write: What is God asking from us in these scriptures?

We are called into the world as Ambassadors of God's loving will, calling us into a life of purpose.

What keeps us or hinders us from doing God's will?

10. Why do you think Jonah ran from the Lord and away from Ninevah?

11. What keeps you from doing what God is calling us to do?

12. Discuss ways and things you can do to overcome those hurdles?
