Main Idea: God’s Name is Holy. Honoring others and the world is honoring God’s name

5. How is calling people names or treating them poorly DISHONORing them? Dishonoring God? Dishonoring the world?

What is in the Bible?

Discuss together and write out responses

Importance of Names- The ancient Hebrews understood that if they knew someone's name, they held some power in the relationship. Revealing a name created a relationship

Read Exodus: 3: 13 - 15

Moses stands before the burning bush and asked who was sending him to Egypt to stand against Pharaoh. Moses asks this not just to strengthen his stand against Egypt but also Moses was asking to be let into a relationship with God, with the one who spoke through the fire and the one who is sending him.

6. How does God answer Moses’ question? How does God’s answer describe or tell who God is?

Small Catechism:

Discuss together and write out responses

Read the First Petition of the Small Catechism and it's meaning

Luther points out that God's name is already holy—there is nothing we can do to change that. God's name is holy because God is Holy, not because of anything humans could do or say. However, we ask in this prayer, that we may become Holy IN and AMONG us.

7. What does it mean to “become Holy IN and AMONG us”?

What we do in God's name can also enhance or hinder the holiness of God's name. That is, our words and actions become a mirror by which others see God's holiness. We honor & dishonor God's name by the way we treat others and the way we treat the world.

Read Matthew 25: 34 - 46

8. What does Jesus say about HOW honoring / dishonoring others in the world is connected to honoring / dishonoring God?

Think of situations recently or in the past:

- * In which situations did you honor God's name? What we say? What we do?
- * In which situations did you dishonor God's name? *(Use the second part of Luther's explanations to help you)*
- * Write these situations / thoughts under the appropriate category
