Faith Talks

“Where do you go to church?”

“Oh, I’m a Lutheran.”

“Lutheran? What’s that?”

Behind the answer to that question is a long history of faith and tradition. Do you know what is unique and special about those who have journeyed the Christian way with the name Lutheran? What do Lutherans stand for and believe? In this conversation you will have a chance to talk about being justified by grace through faith, the central theme of Lutheran belief.

Being a Lutheran

What is This?

Martin Luther once wrote, “A Christian is a perfectly free lord of all, subject to none. A Christian is a perfectly dutiful servant of all, subject to all.” What is this? Luther draws from Paul’s writing in Romans 13:8: “Owe no one anything, except to love one another; for the one who loves another has fulfilled the law.”

Luther says, “Love by its very nature is ready to serve and be subject to the one who is loved. So Christ, although he was Lord of all...was at the same time a free man and a servant.”
