Read the Small Catechism's 3rd Commandment and Luther's meaning.

1. Discuss: What are we talking about when speaking about the "Sabbath"? At a glance what do you think this commandment means?

Read Exodus 20: 8 – 11

2. Discuss where the Israelites were before wandering in the wilderness (slaves in Egypt).

3. How might have the Israelites heard this commandment?

4. Who is the Sabbath for? _____.

Discuss with Parent

5. Does honoring the Sabbath mean not doing anything on the Sabbath?

6. What does it mean to keep something holy?

Somewhere we turned this gift into a burden. It became something we HAVE to do rather than something we get to do.

7. Do you see the Sabbath as a HAVE to or a GET to? What is the difference for you?

8. What prevents you from honoring the Sabbath? What gets in the way?

9. What could happen to our relationship with God and our relationship with others when we allow other things to get in the way of our time with God?

Look at these two words: Re-Creation vs. Wreck - Creation

Discuss with your parent:

10. What is the difference between the two?

11. Why do you suppose God commanded that people take a day to refresh, re-create and remember?
