#### Review

Where are the Israelites? Read Exodus 1: 7 - 8

The Israelites were in Egypt because they were brought there by Joseph because there was a famine in the promise land. But there was about 64 years between Joseph's death and Moses Birth.

The Pharaoh was fearful of the growing numbers of the Israelites so he enslaved them.

# **Birth of Moses**

Pharaoh then ordered the death of all the Hebrew boys when they were born.

Two midwives, Shiphrah and Puah disobeyed. Moses was born and was hid by his mother.

Read Exodus 2: 1 - 11

# Growing up in the Palace

Moses was rescued by Pharaoh's daughter and grew up in the palace. But Moses still identified with the Israelites. When Moses sees an Israelite being beaten by an Egyptian he kills the Egyptian and then runs for his life to Midian. He meets a priest and marries his daughter Zapporah and tends to flocks.

# **Calling of Moses**

God hears the cries of the Israelites and calls moses Read Exodus 3: 1 - 17

Moses was reluctant because he couldn't speak well. So God calls Aaron to help out.

#### Pharaoh

Pharaoh's heart was hardened and would not listen to Moses

# **Escape from Egypt**
