Please read from the Bible together. We encourage you to underline these passages in your Bible.

What does this image make you think about right now?

+ <u>TALK:</u>

In the Psalm we read, it says God's Word can light our path. What do you think this means?

What is your favorite Bible verse? (When you affirm your baptism at the end of confirmation, you will need to choose a verse.)

Do you ever read your Bible outside of church or Confirmation class? (*Honest answers are great.*)

Activity-Free Association Both take a moment to read this aloud, think of the first thing that comes into your mind, jot it down, and then discuss.
