✝ PRAY *Pray together! You can use this prayer or pray using your own words!*

Find a rock for yourself and one for your adult that you work through this lesson with and also find a cross in your house or draw one on a blank piece of paper. Take some silent time to think about something you would like forgiveness for in your life. Hold the rock in your hand and let it represent what you have been thinking about and then set your rock next to the cross. Lay (the rock) your burdens and those things you want forgiveness for at the cross. At the cross, Jesus' death made these burdens and sins things that no longer define us. Instead, we are seen by God as God's beloved children-redeemed and forever loved. Let's pray!

Jesus, thank you for taking my burdens and my sin and letting us leave them at the cross, knowing in hope that resurrection and new life are possible! Help us! Forgive us and remind us that we are your beloved children. In Jesus' name we pray, Amen.
