**Main Idea:** Asking for God's Kingdom to come on Earth. The Kingdom comes through the Holy Spirit.

**Sub Idea:** Living holy lives here on earth

Read From the Catechism:

Review the second petition from Small Catechism

*Your kingdom come.*

#### **What is this?**

In fact, God's kingdom comes on its own without our prayer, but we ask in this prayer that it may also come to us.

#### **How Does This Come About?**

Whenever our heavenly Father gives us his Holy Spirit's grace we believe God's holy work and live godly lives here in time and hereafter in eternity.

Read From Scripture:

Read From Scripture:

Look up Luke 17: 20 - 21

This passage says, “God’s Kingdom is among you.: What do you think that means? If God’s Kingdom is among us what does that mean for me, the church, and our community? (Write your answer here.)

If you could change the world that we live in for the better, to look like God’s Kingdom... how would you change it? (Write your answer here.)

**Discuss Together**

1. Would you rather... be queen / king of a kingdom and have no friends or be a peasant in a village and have LOTS of friends? Why?
2. What do you think about when you think of a Kingdom? How would you define / describe it?
3. Is that definition what we are praying for here in the Lord’s Prayer?
4. It is hard to see God at work in the world. How does the world right now NOT look like God’s Kingdom/What things are happening in the world that do not look like God’s Kingdom?
5. God is always working! God is working in the world and God is working in our lives. Talk about where you do see God working in the world, maybe through the aftermath of tragedy and disasters.

God’s kingdom is a way of life, a set of values, it is about who God is and who we are with God working within us.

Write three things that Jesus did in his life that brought God’s Kingdom to earth.

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God does have a “kingdom” and we pray in this prayer, that we can be a part of it. God’s kingdom is still coming through us, through our own ministry as a church body.

Review TACOS Prayer and focus your prayers today on the A-Adoration. How can your prayer together praise God for who God is?

- T = Thanksgiving
  - A = Adoration (Praising God for who God is)
  - C = Confession
  - O = Others
  - S = Self
- Prayer with one another aloud.
