*Hebrews 10:23-25a "Let us hold tightly without wavering to the hope we affirm, for God can be trusted to keep his promise. Let us think of ways to motivate one another to acts of love and good works. And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but encourage one another..."*

#### ✚ TALK:

- When I hear that I am to "continue in my word," it means that I need to...
- What do you think Jesus means when he says that the "truth will make you free?"
- What does it mean to not give up meeting together in terms of our faith?
