TALK: Discuss with your adult and write your answers.

Share a tradition or ritual that you do in your family (for example: around the Holidays)

What rituals do we do in worship - every Sunday or once a year? Which do you look forward to?

What part of worship do you find the most meaningful and why?

Which part of worship do you think is the oddest to you and why?

READ:

Exodus 8: 1

"Then the LORD said to Moss, 'Go to Pharaoh and say to him, 'Thus says the LORD: Let my people go, so that they may worship me.'"

TALK: Discuss with your adult

- Why would Pharaoh need to let God's people go? Couldn't they worship God in Egypt?
- Why do you think it was important to God that God's people be allowed to worship elsewhere?

READ: Colossians 3: 15 - 17

TALK: Discuss with your adult

- What do the words **Peace, Teach, and Sing** have to do with the worship service?
- What does verse 17 say about how we worship God outside of the church worship service?

TALK: Discuss with your adult and write your answers.
Why is worship the center of our faith?

If liturgy is considered to be the “work of the people” what does that say to you about the importance of worshipping as a community?
